



















Royal Opera House 2017 San Francisco 2018



























Ingolstadt – Munich – Germany


I was commissioned to design an animation for the semi-staged *Opera Romeo and Juliette* by Charles Gounod at The Stadttheater, Germany. The theatre was built in 1964 designed by architects Hardt-Waltherr Hamer and Marie Brigitte Hamer-Burro on Brutalist style wining the BDA Architectural Award. Considering the uniqueness of the building, I decided to use and integrate the concrete walls of the building on the design as a projection surface. The walls dimensions as 14m length and 1.75m width, the strokes of my pencil merged in between the concrete relief surfaces. With just few elements in color, the projection reflects the mood of each scene driven by this extraordinary musical piece.






Several Projects

Part of my job consists of making models. Mostly at scale 1:25, models help Directors, Designers and Producers understand a Desing Concept. Models could be just a simple white card to the most sophisticated model. Materials used range many varieties: from plastics, to card, recyclables, glues, paints, organic materials, all sorts to give the most accurate representation of what a Designer would like to tell. The process normally starts with a hand sketch following a 2D or 3D technical drawing. Before embarking to make a final version, all the creatives needs to agree on the final design, specially Directors and Producers.





















MARY POPPINS THE MUSICAL - DELVELOP FOR WORLD TOUR








The barn is on a very bad state of repairing but the clients want to keep the whole structure it intact. Surrounded by trees and flowering bushes, the clients want to keep the




